BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Born in Council Bluffs, Iowa on April 11, 1916, Robert Denney graduated from Fairbury High School, Fairbury, Nebraska in 1933. He attended Peru State Teachers College and the University of Nebraska from 1933 to 1936, and graduated from Creighton University's School of Law in 1939. He practiced law in Fairbury, Nebraska and then became a special agent for the Federal Bureau of Investigation, serving in Washington, D.C. and Chicago.

Denney enlisted in the U.S. Marine Corps in October 1942 with the First Armored Amphibian Battalion. He remained active in the U.S. Marine Corps Reserve until 1960 when he retired with the rank of lieutenant colonel. He resumed practicing law in Fairbury, Nebraska and became Jefferson County attorney and Fairbury city attorney. He was the Jefferson County Republican chairman, and then chairman of the Nebraska Republican Party. Denney was elected to the U.S. Congress and served from January 3, 1967 to January 3, 1971. He did not run for re-election.

Denney was appointed U.S. District Court Judge in 1971. He was a member of the Presbyterian Church, the American Bar Association, the American Legion, Veterans of Foreign Wars, Phi Sigma Kappa, the Freemasons, Knights Templar (Freemason degree), the Shriners and the Lions. He resided in Omaha, Nebraska until his death on June 26, 1981. Robert V. Denney is buried in Fairbury Cemetery, in Fairbury, Nebraska.

After Robert Denney's death, a bill was proposed in the U.S. Congress to designate the building known as the Lincoln Federal Building and Courthouse in Lincoln, Nebraska, as the "Robert V. Denney Federal Building and Courthouse." The bill passed and became law on December 21, 1981.
