HISTORICAL NOTE

Nebraska Game and Parks Commission are responsible for managing fish, wildlife, park, and outdoor recreational resources in the state. The Commission executes and implements policies or programs to meet that objective. The Board of Commissioners is appointed by the governor for six-year terms. Games and Parks are organized into twelve divisions: Administration, Boating, Budget and Fiscal, Engineering, Fisheries, Information and Education, Law Enforcement, Operations and Construction, State Parks, Planning and Programming, Realty, and Wildlife.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

This series contains bound volumes organized in chronological order for jobs completed or work in progress by personnel of Nebraska Game and Parks. These report contain various surveys and studies involving wildlife and fisheries (examples: banding, population levels, distribution mapping, and seasonal movements).
