HISTORICAL NOTE

Prior to Nebraska becoming a state, the public welfare need of its residents was provided for under a pauper law. This law can be found in chapter 39 of the Revised Statutes of Nebraska Territory in 1866. It stated that most of the responsibility for the care of the paupers lay on their families to take care of their own. If the family was unable to care for them, the authority was given to the County Commissioners to oversee the paupers and establish poor houses in the counties. After statehood in 1867, public welfare provisions were expanded. The Legislature provided for indigents and people in need of institutional care. Short-term crisis aid was also available to Nebraska residents. In 1919, the first State Department of Welfare was created. It encompassed the Bureau of Child Welfare, and was given the former duties of the Board of Charities and Corrections. This department was abolished in 1931. In 1937, the Department of Assistance and Child Welfare was established under the Board of Control. In 1961, the Board of Control was eliminated and in 1962, the Department of Public Welfare became an executive department. In 1973, the social services function was separated from the welfare assistance function of the state department and its county divisions. Title XX of the Social Security Act replaced the existing social services program. This greatly changed the way federal funds were spent and administered by the states. In 1983, social service programs direct administration was transferred from county boards to the state in order to provide consistent program administration and policy statewide. Big changes occurred in 1984, when the department's "public welfare" title was eliminated to more accurately reflect its purpose of giving assistance to Nebraskans who could not support themselves. The department was renamed The Department of Social Services.

LB 1044, the Nebraska Partnership for Health and Human Services Act, was passed by the Legislature in April 1996. On Dec. 31, 1996, LB 1044 eliminated the Aging, Health, Public Institutions and Social Services departments, as well as the Office of Juvenile Services in the Department of Correctional Services. A unified system of three new functionally organized agencies was created beginning Jan. 1, 1997.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

This collection consists of the records of the Nebraska Department of Social Services excluding records of the newly combined Department of Health and Human Services. Records of this department 1996 to current are shelved with the new collection for the combined agency in RG97.

The collection is divided into seven subgroups: 1) Administration 1963-1988; 2) Manual Unit, 1936-1976; 3) Enforcement Services, 1972-1978; 4) Human Services, 1967-1984; 5) Technical Assistance, 1964-1980; 6) Foster Care Review Board, 1988-1989; 7) Public Assistance and Food Programs, 1982-1985.

Subgroup 1 contains administrative correspondence for all phases of Social Services and Welfare in Nebraska from 1963 to 1996. Some of these include, ADC - Aid to Dependent Children, Juvenile Services, Child Foster Care, Adoption, Abuse and Domestic Violence, Child Protective Services, and records of the District Office. This is an open collection with records being added each year.

Subgroup 2 consists of records of manual history of the agency from 1919-1976.

Subgroup 3 is Enforcement Services. It contains one series called program evaluation and review. Dates span from 1972-1978.

Subgroup 4 is Human Services which includes information on the Task Force on Domestic Violence, Government Advisory Committee on Day Care, and Legislation regarding the agency from 1967-1984. Also included are published reference materials concerning Human Services.

Subgroup 5 contains Technical Assistance program files such as weatherization and energy programs.

Subgroup 6 contains Foster Care Review Board correspondence files from 1981-1993. The remainder of the subgroup is closed and not open to the public.

Subgroup 7 contains Public Assistance and Food Programs from 1982-1985. It includes legislation on the distribution of food, child nutrition, and Federal surveys.
