

RG6045: Greiner, Loren, 1908-2016

Papers, photos, moving images: 1935-1942
Bridgeport, Morrill County, Neb.: CCC worker

What will I find in this collection?

RG6045.AM: The manuscript portion of the collection consists of progress reports for conservation work conducted at Bridgeport, Nebraska, by Civilian Conservation Corps soil technician Loren Greiner. The information dates from 1937-1939.

RG6045.MI: The moving image component consists of eight reels of 16mm amateur footage shot by Loren Greiner, mostly relating to his time at the CCC camps in Denton and Bridgeport. Also includes a Nebraska football game at Memorial Stadium and various family scenes, ca. 1935-1942.

RG6045.PH: The photo component consists of 40 photographic prints relating to Loren Greiner and his time in the Civilian Conservation Corps. Images include the CCC camp at Fairbury (1937), Greiner surveying land near Fairbury (1937), CCC irrigation work near Morrill, Neb., a circus at Fairbury (1937), family photos and a home damaged by an oil tank explosion. Also included are postcards of Madison, Neb., and Courthouse Rock.

How do I find more detailed information about this collection?

This cover sheet is the only finding aid available for the collection.

What restrictions govern the use of this collection?

Researchers must wear gloves when handling photographic materials.
