What will I find in this collection?

RG5971.AM: The collection consists of one box of records relating to the Woman's Relief Corps Russell Relief Corps No. 86 of Fairbury, Nebraska. Materials date from 1891-1947 and include the original charter, applications for membership (1892-1947), secretary and treasurer's reports (1938-1940), a Memorial Day report (1943), an announcement regarding the assassination of President McKinley (1901), and three ledgers (1905-1940) listing memberships and general finances.
